RESOLUTION TO AMEND PARAGRAPH THREE OF RESOLUTION 99.021

WHEREAS, the Village of Blanchester passed Resolution No. 99.021 to establish the Village of Blanchester Recreation Board; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Blanchester desires to amend the Resolution pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 731.19; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 99.021 is attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Blanchester, Clinton County, Ohio that:

SECTION 1.

Resolution No. 99.021, paragraph three, will now read: **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code, Section 755.14, there be and hereby is established The Blanchester Recreation Board. The Board shall consist of five (5) persons, two of whom shall be members of the Board of Education of the Blanchester School District or members appointed by such Board of Education. The other members of the Board shall be appointed by the Mayor of the Village of Blanchester with the consent of the Blanchester Village Council. The members who are Board of Education members and members appointed by the Board of Education shall be residents of the school district making the appointment but need not be residents of the municipal corporation. All other members of the board shall be residents of the municipal corporation. All members shall serve terms of five (5) years, except that members first appointed shall be appointed for such terms that the term of one member shall expire annually thereafter. Members of the Board shall serve without pay. The Blanchester Recreation Board shall possess all the powers and be subject to all the responsibilities of the respective local authorities under Sections 755.12 to 755.18 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 2.

The Village of Blanchester finds and determines that all formal actions of this Village concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Village of Blanchester and that all deliberations of this Village of Blanchester that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 3.

The resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, or welfare of the residents of the Village of Blanchester.

SECTION 4.

That the Village by at least a three-fourths vote hereby dispenses with the requirement that this Resolution be read on three separate days and hereby authorizes the adoption of the Resolution upon its first reading. That this Resolution shall be effective at the earliest date allowed by law.

SECTION 5.

This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its adoption.

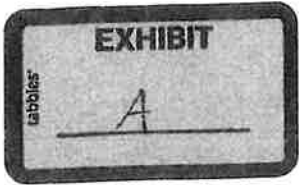

RESOLUTION No. 99.021

RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH VILLAGE OF BLANCHESTER RECREATION BOARD

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The Village of Blanchester, Clinton County, Ohio, as follows:

WHEREAS, the Village Council recognizes the need to establish a Recreation Board to oversee the operation and maintenance of parks, playgrounds and play fields within the Village.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that, pursuant to Section 755.14, Ohio Revised Code, there be and hereby is established The Blanchester Recreation Board. The Board shall consist of five (5) persons, two (2) of whom shall be members of the Board of Education of the Blanchester School District or members appointed by such Board. The other members of the Board shall be appointed by the Mayor of the Village of Blanchester with the consent of the Blanchester Village Council. All members of the Board shall be residents of the Village of Blanchester and shall serve for terms of five (5) years, except that the members first appointed shall be appointed for such terms that the term of one member shall expire annually thereafter. Members of the Board shall serve without pay. The Blanchester Recreation Board shall possess all the powers and be subject to all the responsibilities of the respective local authorities under Sections 755.12 to 755.18 of the Ohio Revised Code.
