

ORDINANCE NO. 2023.019

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING ON SOUTH BROADWAY STREET IN FRONT OF PARCEL 2201101010015VA

WHEREAS, the parking of cars on South Broadway Street in front of parcel 2201101010015VA decreases the visibility for the traveling public; and

WHEREAS, this Council believes that prohibiting parking on South Broadway Street in front of parcel 2201101010015VA will increase the safety and overall general welfare of the Village of Blanchester and the traveling public; and

WHEREAS, this Council is authorized to regulate the stopping and parking of vehicles pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 4511.07; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Ohio Revised Code 4521.02, this Council does not desire a violation of this Ordinance to be considered a criminal offense; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Blanchester, Clinton County, Ohio that:

Section 1: Parking Prohibited

Parking is hereby prohibited on South Broadway Street in front of parcel 2201101010015VA.

Section 2: Penalty

In accordance with the Village of Blanchester Fine Schedule, whomever violates this section shall be fined **\$ 20.00** for each day the violation occurs if payment occurs within thirty (30) days. If payment occurs after thirty (30) days the fine shall be increased to **\$50.00**

Section 3

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

Section 4

This Ordinance shall be read three times and shall be in full force and effect from and after the first date provided by law. All prior legislation, or subsection in an Ordinance that is not consistent with this Ordinance shall be repealed effective immediately.

Section 5

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its adoption.
