A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING MAYOR JOHN CARMAN TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND / OR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM(S) FOR THE FANCY STREET WATER TOWER REHABILITATION PROJECT AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Blanchester is planning to make capital improvements to Fancy Street Water Tower Rehabilitation, and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC programs,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BLANCHESTER:

Section 1: The **Mayor, John M. Carman** is hereby authorized to apply to the OPWC for funds as described above.

Section 2: The **Mayor, John M. Carman** is authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

Section 3: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure to ensure compliance Due to time constraints to apply for funding with OPWC. Following appropriate legislative action, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law

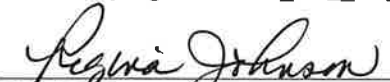
