

RESOLUTION 2024.002

A RESOLUTION CENSURING COUNCIL MEMBER, JOSHUA PARKS

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Blanchester, Clinton County, Ohio that:

SECTION 1

That the conduct of council member, **JOSHUA PARKS**, breaks traditions of a welcoming environment that the Village of Blanchester has always embraced. Council Member Parks, on a regular basis, tends to bring the Village Council into disrepute, spreading falsities and misinformation on social media platforms, and ultimately making the lives of village employees more difficult to do their jobs which is to work for the citizens of the Village of Blanchester. Such conduct is hereby condemned and Council formally asks Council Member Parks to discontinue using tactics that harm the Village government and community members.

SECTION 2

The Village of Blanchester finds and determines that all formal actions of this Village concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Village of Blanchester and that all deliberations of this Village of Blanchester that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 3

Council Member Park's actions are a hinderance to the Village of Blanchester's ability to conduct its official business in an effective manner. Therefore, the resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, or welfare of the residents of the Village of Blanchester.

SECTION 4


This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its adoption.
