

Resolution No. 2021.044

A RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO RELINQUISH THE RIGHT TO GIVE STEP RAISES TO BOARD OF PUBLIC AFFAIR EMPLOYEES TO THE BOARD OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS TRUSTEES

WHEREAS, the Blanchester Village Council wishes to relinquish the right to approve step raises back to the Board of Public Affairs Trustees, who are a respected and elected body of the Village of Blanchester; and

WHEREAS, the Blanchester Board of Public Affairs Trustees will regain the right to approve step raises. No employee of the Board of Public Affairs shall receive a step raise more frequently than twelve months without the approval of the Blanchester Village Council except in the case of employees coming off probation; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village of Blanchester hereby relinquishes the power to give step raises to Board of Public Affairs employees to the Board of Public Affairs Trustees without prior approval of Council.


Mr. Hollon moved to suspend the rules for three readings. Mr. Brumbaugh seconded the motion with the roll being called and the vote resulted as follows:




