

RESOLUTION NO. 2021.039

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF BLANCHESTER FISCAL OFFICER TO REMOVE INACTIVE FUNDS FROM THE VILLAGE BOOKS

WHEREAS, the Village of Blanchester's year end accounting is approaching, and the Fiscal Officer has made Council aware that there are certain funds, attached and incorporated herein as Exhibit A, that have no activity and are for purposes and/or projects that have been completed and are no longer needed; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer has noted that under the UAN accounting system, the only time that inactive/completed funds may be removed is at the year end closing; and

NOW THEREFORE, upon consideration of the foregoing, Council finds it necessary and appropriate, two-thirds or more of the members elected thereto concurring to the following:

1) The Fiscal Officer shall be authorized to remove any funds in the UAN accounting system that no longer have any activity because the project and/or purpose has been fulfilled and is no longer of use.

2) Council, through 3/4ths of its members, vote to allow the passage of this resolution with only one reading, dispensing with the requirement for three separate readings under R.C. 731.17.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Blanchester, Ohio, two-thirds or more of the members elected thereto concurring, that:

Mr. Gephart made a motion to suspend the rules for three readings and to approve adoption. Mr. Brumbaugh seconded the motion and the roll being called upon its adoption the vote resulted as follows:
