

# RESOLUTION NO. 2018.009

## DECLARING A NECESSITY FOR AND AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF \$100,000.00 FROM THE ELECTRIC FUND TO THE SEWER FUND OF THE VILLAGE OF BLANCHESTER TO COMPLY WITH THE REQUEST OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE PUBLIC AFFAIRS

**WHEREAS**, Council has given due consideration to the necessity for 2018 standard operating procedures of the Village of Blanchester which is under control of the Board of Public Affairs of said Village; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of Public Affairs has requested that the Village Council authorize that the transfer of \$100,000.00 be made from said Electric Fund to the Sewer Fund; and

**WHEREAS**, it is determined by Council that the ending balance of said Electric Fund for the period ending December 31, 2017 was \$2,564,344.90, and is sufficient to maintain and operate the Electric Fund for the foreseeable future, and that a request for the transfer of \$100,000.00 from the Electric Fund to the Sewer Fund is reasonable and immediately necessary, same being under construction.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Village Solicitor and the Fiscal Officer of said Village be and they hereby are authorized to prepare a petition to be filed in the Ohio Department of Taxation, requesting an order to secure the approval as required by law, particularly Ohio Revised Code Sections 5705.14, 5705.15, and 5705.16, and that all the required information be submitted to the Ohio Tax Commission for its consideration and approval.


