

# RESOLUTION NO. 2018.027

## A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 2018.008 DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO ADVANCE \$40,000 TO THE SEWER FUND (5201) FROM THE GENERAL FUND (1000) AND EXTENDING THE TIME FOR REPAYMENT

**WHEREAS**, the Council for the Village of Blanchester, Clinton County, Ohio has previously adopted Resolution 2018.008 providing for the advance of \$40,000 to the Sewer Fund (5201) from the General Fund (1000), a copy of said Resolution 2018.008 being attached hereto as and incorporated herein by reference; and,

**WHEREAS**, Resolution 2018.008 provided the advance shall be repaid no later than May 31, 2018; and

**WHEREAS**, in light of the Village's pending Petition before the Ohio Department of Taxation for transfer of public funds, the Council finds it necessary and desirable to extend the time for repayment to December 31, 2018 by amending Resolution 2018.008.

**NOWHEREFORE**, be it Resolved by the Council for the Village of Blanchester, to amend Resolution 2018.008, repealing the same, and replacing in its entirety as follows:

**Section I:** That there be and hereby be advanced the sum of \$40,000 (forty thousand dollars and no cents) to the Sewer Fund (5201) from the General Fund (1000).

**Section II:** This Resolution is necessary to fund standard operating procedures for their continued operation. This advance from the General Fund will be repaid by December 31, 2018.

**Section III:** That this Resolution shall be declared an emergency for necessity of health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Blanchester and shall be effective upon passage and signing by the Mayor.


