

RESOLUTION NO. 2025.023

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR OF THE VILLAGE OF BLANCHESTER, OHIO, TO APPLY TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM (TAP) FUNDING

WHEREAS, The Village of Blanchester, Ohio, is eligible to apply for Transportation Alternatives Program funding for the Municipal Building Sidewalk Improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Blanchester, Ohio, that:

Section One. The Village of Blanchester, Ohio, is hereby authorized and directed to apply to the Ohio Department of Transportation for the Transportation Alternatives Program funds.

Section Two. That upon completion of the described Project, and unless otherwise agreed, the Village of Blanchester, Ohio shall: (1) provide adequate maintenance for the described Project in accordance with all applicable state and federal laws, including, but not limited to 23 USC 116; (2) provide ample financial provisions, as necessary, for the maintenance of the described Project; (3) if necessary, maintain the right-of-way, keeping it free of obstruction; and (4) if necessary, hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes.

Section Three. That if the application is approved for the funding, the Mayor of the Village of Blanchester, Ohio, is hereby empowered on behalf of the Village of Blanchester, Ohio, to enter into a contract and/or other documents with the Director of the Ohio Department of Transportation necessary to complete the above-described Project.

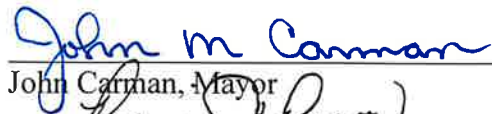
Section Four. It is found that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relation to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code, and the Rules of Council.

Section Five. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the people of this municipality, and shall take effect at the earliest date provided by law. This Resolution must be passed as an emergency due to time constraints.

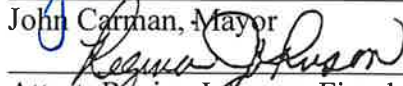

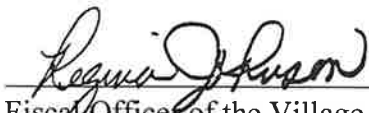
