

RESOLUTION NO. 2026.015

RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 2022.007 AND THE VILLAGE OF BLANCHESTER PUBLIC COMMENT POLICY

WHEREAS, the Village of Blanchester (“Village”) passed Resolution 2022.007 to adopt a Public Comment Policy for the Village of Blanchester’s council meetings; and

WHEREAS, Village Council previously discontinued its former public comment process during regular Council meetings; and

WHEREAS, the Village desires to reestablish an opportunity for residents to address Village Council regarding matters of public interest; and

WHEREAS, the Village finds that quarterly Town Hall Forums will promote transparency, communication, and community engagement within the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Blanchester desires to revise the public comment policy pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 731.19.

WHEREAS, Resolution 2022.007 is attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Blanchester, Ohio, to revise Resolution 2022.007 so that it may read:

SECTION 1.

VILLAGE OF BLANCHESTER TOWN HALL FORUM POLICY

The Council for the Village of Blanchester welcomes public comments at Town Hall Forums. Thus, the Village hereby adopts the following policy governing Town Hall Forums:

- A. The purpose of the Town Hall Forum (“Forum”) is to provide the community with an opportunity to address Village officials regarding matters of public concern, ask questions, and offer feedback in an open public forum.
- B. The Village shall conduct a Forum on a quarterly basis. Each Forum shall be held during March, June, September, and December, on dates, times, and locations established by the Village and publicly posted in advance. Forums are separate from Council meetings unless specifically combined by Council action.
- C. At least one (1) week prior to each Forum, the Village shall post a list of topics to be discussed. The list of topics shall be posted:
 - a. On the Village’s Facebook page; and
 - b. At the following locations:
 - i. Blanchester Municipal Building, 318 E. Main Street

- ii. First National Bank, 121 E. Main Street
- iii. Blanchester Post Office, 115 S. Wright Street
- iv. Tom's Express Mart, 7529 Fairground Road
- v. Blanchester Public Library, 110 N. Broadway Street

D. Public comment during the Forums may address

- a. Village services, operations, and programs;
- b. Community concerns;
- c. Suggestions for future improvements; and
- d. Questions relating to Village policies and/or projects.

The Forum is intended as a public forum for dialogue and is not required to result in formal action by Council at the meeting. Council will not discuss matters related to pending or imminent litigation, matters subject to confidentiality under state or federal law, or issues unrelated to Village business or the stated purpose of the Forum.

- E. Anyone attending the meeting may participate during the Forum, subject to the procedures and time limits set forth in this policy. Speakers will be asked to provide:
 - a. Their name;
 - b. Address; and
 - c. Which topic from the posted list of topics they intend to discuss.
- F. Individuals wishing to speak may be asked to sign in before the Forum begins. The sign in process may include the speaker's name, address, and topic. The Village may also permit registration through another method established by the Village Administration.
- G. Each speaker shall be allowed three (3) minutes to address Council during the Forum.
- H. All participants in the Forum shall conduct themselves in a respectful and orderly manner. Speakers shall direct comments to Village Council as a body. The following are prohibited:
 - a. Profane, obscene, or threatening language;
 - b. Comments that disrupt, delay, or impede the orderly conduct of the Forum;
 - c. Shouting, interrupting, or speaking out of turn; and
 - d. Conduct that creates a safety concern or interferes with the rights of others to participate.

I. The presiding officer may:

- a. Interrupt or terminate an individual's statement when the statement goes in excess of three (3) minutes and is not extended by the Council;
- b. Rule comments or conduct out of order;
- c. Request that disruptive individuals cease inappropriate behavior;
- d. Request any individual to leave the Forum when that individual's conduct causes a disruption to the Forum;
- e. Request the assistance of law enforcement officers in the removal of an individual who causes a disruption to the Forum; and
- f. Request a motion for adjournment when a disruption prevents the Council from completing Forum.

J. Council may, at their discretion:

- a. Respond to questions during the Forum;
- b. Refer matters to Village staff for follow-up; or
- c. Request additional information from the speaker.

If a question or issue raised during the Town Hall cannot be addressed at the meeting, Council may provide a follow-up response at a later date, where deemed appropriate.

K. Individuals may submit written comments before, during, or after the Forum session in a manner established by the Village.

L. The Village shall make reasonable efforts to ensure Forums are accessible to the public. Individuals needing accommodations to participate should contact the Village in advance of the meeting, when possible.

SECTION 2.

The Village of Blanchester finds and determines that all formal actions of this Village concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Village of Blanchester and that all deliberations of this Village of Blanchester that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 3.

That the Village by at least a three/fourths vote hereby dispenses with the requirement that this Resolution be read on three separate days and hereby authorizes the adoption of the Resolution upon its first reading. That this Resolution shall be effective at the earliest date allowed by law.

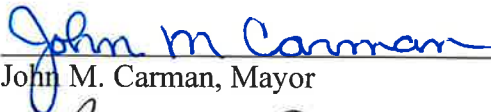
SECTION 4.

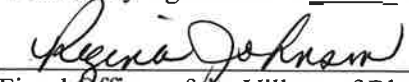

**RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION
2017.019 AND THE VILLAGE OF
BLANCHESTER PUBLIC COMMENT
POLICY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village of Blanchester passed Resolution 2017-019 to adopt a Public Comment Policy for the Village of Blanchester's council meetings;

WHEREAS, the Village of Blanchester desires to revise the public comment policy pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 731.19.

WHEREAS, Resolution 2017-019 is attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Blanchester, Ohio, to revise the Public Comment Policy so that it may read:

Section 1.

VILLAGE OF BLANCHESTER PUBLIC COMMENT POLICY

The Blanchester Village Council welcomes public comments at their meetings and sets aside time in the agenda for public comment. All meetings of the Council are open to the public, subject to Executive Session Privilege. In order to permit the fair and orderly expression of such Public Comment, the Council shall provide a period for public participation at every regular meeting as follows:

- A. Public participation shall be permitted as indicated on the order of business.
- B. Anyone attending the meeting may participate during the public portion of a meeting.
- C. Speakers shall be recognized by the presiding officer and will be requested to preface their comments by an announcement of their name, address, and group affiliation, if appropriate.
- D. Each statement made by a Speaker shall be limited to three (3) minutes duration, unless extended by Council.
- E. Participants shall present their comments as a speech or monologue; participants are not to address or pose questions to any Council members, employees or officials individually.
- F. The presiding officer may:
 - i. Interrupt or terminate a participant's statement when the statement goes in excess of three (3) minutes and is not extended by the Council;
 - ii. Request any individual to leave the meeting when that person's conduct causes a disruption to the Council completing and conducting business;
 - iii. Request the assistance of law enforcement officers in the removal of a person who causes a disruption to the Council completing and conducting business;
 - iv. Request a motion for recess or an adjournment to another time when a disruption prevents the Council from completing and conducting its business.

Section 2.

The Village of Blanchester finds and determines that all formal actions of this Village concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Village of Blanchester and that all deliberations of this Village of Blanchester that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 3.

The resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, or welfare of the residents of the Village of Blanchester.

Section 4.

That the Village by at least a three-fourths vote hereby dispenses with the requirement that this Resolution be read on three separate days and hereby authorizes the adoption of the Resolution upon its first reading. That this Resolution shall be effective at the earliest date allowed by law.

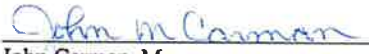
