

RESOLUTION 2026.022

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, AND ENTER INTO A WATER SUPPLY REVOLVING LOAN ACCOUNT (WSRLA) AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE OF BLANCHESTER FOR CONSTRUCTION OF WATER FACILITIES; AND DESIGNATING A DEDICATED REPAYMENT SOURCE FOR THE LOAN:

Whereas, the Village of Blanchester seeks to upgrade its existing water facilities; and

Whereas, the Village of Blanchester intends to apply for Water Supply Revolving Loan Account (WSRLA) for the construction of the water facilities; and

Whereas, the Ohio Water Supply Revolving Loan Account (WSRLA) requires the government authority to pass legislation for application of a loan and the execution of an agreement as well as designating a dedicated repayment source;

Now therefore, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Blanchester, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the mayor be and is hereby authorized to apply for a WSRLA loan, sign all documents for and enter into a Water Supply Revolving Loan Account (WSRLA) with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and the Ohio Water Development Authority for construction of water facilities on behalf of the Village of Blanchester, Ohio.

SECTION 2. That the dedicated source of repayment will be water utility funds.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the people of this municipality, and shall take effect at the earliest date provided by law. This Resolution must be passed as an emergency due to time constraints to meet the application deadline.

SECTION 4. That is resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

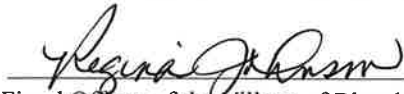
