ORDINANCE NO. 2022.033

ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 2021.003, TITLED “AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE SALARY FOR THE MAYOR, COUNCIL AND BOARD OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS FOR THE VILLAGE OF BLANCHESTER”

WHEREAS, the Village of Blanchester passed Ordinance No. 2021.003 to establish the salary for the Mayor, Council, and Board of Public Affairs for the Village of Blanchester; and

WHEREAS, the salaries and provisions proposed in Ordinance No. 2021.003 are no longer in the best interest of the Village of Blanchester considering the current and forecasted economic challenges facing the Village of Blanchester;

WHEREAS, the Village of Blanchester desires to amend Ordinance No. 2021.003 pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 731.19; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Blanchester, Clinton County, Ohio that:

SECTION 1.

Ordinance No. 2021.003, titled “[a]n ordinance establishing the salary for the Mayor, Council and Board of Public Affairs for the Village of Blanchester”, is hereby amended as shown in the attached Exhibit A.

SECTION 2.

The existing Ordinance No. 2021.003 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3.

The Village of Blanchester finds and determines that all formal actions of this Village concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of the Village of Blanchester and that all deliberations of this Village of Blanchester that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 4.

That the Village by at least a three-fourths vote hereby dispenses with the requirement that this Resolution be read on three separate days and hereby authorizes the adoption of the Resolution upon its first reading. That this Resolution shall be effective at the earliest date allowed by law.

SECTION 5.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its adoption.

ORDINANCE NO. 2022.033

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE SALARY FOR THE MAYOR, COUNCIL AND BOARD OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS FOR THE VILLAGE OF BLANCHESTER.

WHEREAS, O.R.C. Section 731.13 provides that the legislative authority of a village shall fix compensation, and the Village Council hereby fixes the compensation of Village officials, employees, appointees, and volunteers for the Village of Blanchester, Clinton County, Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Blanchester, Clinton County, Ohio, the following salaries for the following Village Officials:

1. The Mayor's salary shall be \$17,000 annually, payable in 12 equal monthly installments.
2. Council members shall receive an annual salary of \$3,200, each payable in 12 monthly installments.
3. Board of Public Affairs members shall receive an annual salary of \$3,200, each payable in 12 monthly installments.
4. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately with salary increases occurring upon the commencement of the next term for each office subsequent to its passage.
5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of the Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including all lawful ordinances and any applicable provisions of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
6. All prior legislation, or any part thereof, which is inconsistent with this Ordinance is hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereof.
