

RESOLUTION NO. 2025.015

RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO LEVY A TAX IN EXCESS OF THE TEN-MILL LIMITATION

The Council of the Village of Blanchester in Clinton County, Ohio, met in a special session on the 31st day of July, 2025, at the office of the Blanchester Municipal Building, with the following members present: Marie Brooker, Reilly Hopkins, Lynn Lewis, and Josh Parks.

WHEREAS, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the Village of Blanchester, Clinton County, Ohio;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BLANCHESTER, Clinton County Ohio, two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring, that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation for the benefit of the Village of Blanchester for the purposes of current operating expenses which levy is authorized by **Section 5705.19 (A)** of the Ohio Revised Code, at a rate not exceeding four (4) mills for each dollar of valuation, which amounts to **forty cents (\$.40) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five (5) years commencing in 2025 (the first year the tax will be levied), first due in calendar year 2026 (the first year in which the tax shall be due)** being a **RENEWAL** of an existing tax of four (4) mills; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the question of levying additional taxes BE SUBMITTED BY THE ELECTORS OF SAID Village of Blanchester at the Election to be held at the usual voting places within said Village of Blanchester on the 4th day of November, 2025; and be it further

RESOLVED, that said levy be placed upon the tax list of the current year after the **February settlement** next succeeding the election, if a majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Fiscal Officer of this Village of Blanchester Council be hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Board of Elections, Clinton County seventy-five (75) days prior to the General Election to be held November 4th, 2025 and notify said Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law.

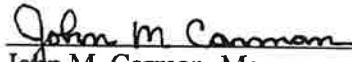

This Resolution must be passed as an emergency due to time constraints.

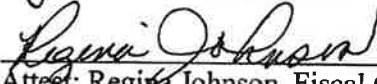
Council member Mr. Parks __, moved to adopt this Resolution, and __Mr. Hopkins__,

CERTIFICATE OF ESTIMATED PROPERTY TAX REVENUE

The County Auditor of Clinton County, Ohio does hereby certify the following:

1. On MAY 29, 2025 the taxing authority of the VILLAGE OF BLANCHESTER, certified a copy of its resolution adopted on MAY 22, 2025 requesting the county auditor to certify the current tax valuation of the subdivision and the amount of revenue that would be produced by 4.0 mill(s), to levy a tax outside the ten-mill limitation for CURRENT EXPENSE purposes pursuant to Revised Code §5705.19(A) to be placed on the ballot at the NOVEMBER 4, 2025 GENERAL election. The levy type is a RENEWAL Levy.
2. The estimated property tax revenue that will be produced by the stated millage, assuming the tax valuation of the subdivision remains constant throughout the life of the levy, is calculated to be \$177,753
3. The total tax valuation of the subdivision used in calculating the estimated property tax revenue is \$102,677,240
4. The millage for the requested levy is 4.0 mills per \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$41.00 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value.
