

The legislative authority for the Village of Blanchester, Clinton County, Ohio (hereinafter the "Council") met in regular session on the 11th day of February, 2021 at 7:00 pm with the following members present: Richard Simpson, Chad Hollon, Reilly Hopkins, Harry Brumbaugh, Don Gephart and Gary Bauer. Also present was Mayor John Carman and Fiscal Officer Jewelie Casteel.

Mr. Reilly Hopkins moved the following:

ORDINANCE NO. 2021.003

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE SALARY FOR THE MAYOR, COUNCIL AND BOARD OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS FOR THE VILLAGE OF BLANCHESTER.

WHEREAS, O.R.C. Section 731.13 provides that the legislative authority of a village shall fix compensation, and the Village Council hereby fixes the compensation of Village officials, employees, appointees, and volunteers for the Village of Blanchester, Clinton County, Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Blanchester, Clinton County, Ohio, the following salaries for the following Village Officials:

1. So long as the Mayor holds full-time employment outside his or her position as Mayor, then the salary for said Mayor shall be \$17,000 annually, payable in 12 equal monthly installments.
2. So long as the Mayor both: (a) does not hold full-time employment outside his or her position as Mayor; and (b) dedicates not fewer than 30 hours of service per week to his or her Mayoral duties then the salary for said Mayor shall be \$30,000 annually, payable in 12 equal monthly installments.
3. "Full-time employment", for purposes of this Ordinance, shall be defined as employment by one or more employers, as either an employee or an independent contractor, and which all such employment, collectively, requires an average of more than 30 hours of dedicated service per week.
4. Council members shall receive an annual salary of \$3,600 and the Vice-Mayor shall receive an annual salary of \$4,200, each payable in 12 monthly installments.
5. Board of Public Affairs members shall receive an annual salary of \$3,600 and the Chairman shall receive an annual salary of \$4,200, each payable in 12 monthly installments.
6. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately with salary increases occurring upon the commencement of the next term for each office subsequent to its passage.
7. It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of the Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including all lawful ordinances and any applicable provisions of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
8. All prior legislation, or any part thereof, which is inconsistent with this Ordinance is hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereof.
